**How a Bill Becomes a Law**

1. Debate an issue in House or Senate
2. Write a bill
3. Add amendments
4. Vote on the bill (need 51% to pass)
5. Introduce the bill in the other house
6. Combine the 2 bills into 1
7. Both houses vote again
8. The president signs the bill into law
